

MISE A DISPOSITION DU CONNECTEUR OUTLOOK

INTRODUCTION

The BlueMind Subscription includes the connector that allows you to synchronize domain user accounts with Outlook's email client.

This connector allows users to synchronize their BlueMind calendar and settings as well as address books.

INSTALLATION

For users to be able to access the Outlook connector, all you need to and must do is install the package `bm-connector-outlook` once the subscription is installed.

Typically, this is done during [subscription installation](#), but you can install packages separately.

On the main server, (where BlueMind is installed) install the package:

Debian/Ubuntu

```
| sudo aptitude install bm-connector-outlook
```

RedHat

```
| yum install bm-connector-outlook
```



There's no need to restart bm service.

USERS PROVISIONING

Once installed, users can download the connector from the Downloads section of their settings page:
